

# FEMA TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

## (NOT REQUIRED FOR HAM WATCH)

Following a FEMA and State mandate, Clallam County Emergency Management Department **requires** the following training of all CC-ARES volunteers for duty in the County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and Emergency Communications Centers (ECC), i.e. Sequim, Diamond Point, Port Angeles, Forks, the Hospitals and others.
