

Emergency Volunteer Worker Deployment LEVELS...

All Emergency Volunteer Workers must work **only within the scope of their sponsoring agencies training.** That would be the Clallam County Amateur Radio Club (CCARC) in collaboration with Clallam County Emergency Management (CCEM). The activities authorized would be as follows:

Surveillance reporting

AHAB siren observer reports

Message Center Work

Weather Spotter reporting

CERT relay work (this is still under development and the scope of this responsibility will need to be determined by CCARES and CCEM).

Levels 1 is the volunteer who would be called upon for a local disaster. The preparation would include application w/ background check. Task specific training would be provided by their lead agency – in this case, the Clallam County Amateur Radio Club and Clallam County Emergency Management. This would be a "call me when you need me" level of response.

Levels 2 would include the above plus incremental trainings compliant with the National Incident Management System & the National Response Framework. The back of this page includes the list of Incident Command System Trainings for compliance. These amateur radio members could be asked to be deployed to local area away from their homes, State, or National responses.

NOTIFICATION for DEPLOYMENTS...

{Proposed} Utilize a designated group of HAM radio operators from the Clallam County A.R.E.S operators to manage deployment notifications. There will only be ONE contact list.

Layers of Notification:

Communication tree with two modes – telephone & email

Enhanced Telephone Notification System (i.e. Reverse 911) that calls on land lines to emergency volunteer worker groups instantly.

Public Radio Announcement (KONP; KBDB; KSQM; KAPS; KIRO) to call for Emergency Volunteer Workers to call the designated phone number for activation information.

Emergency Volunteer Workers would have the designated inside number to the Clallam County Emergency Operations Center to call for activation information.
